INTRODUCTION

Global Heat Health Information Network

The Global Heat Health Information Network (GHHIN), an UN initiative co-sponsored by the World Health Organization (WHO), the World Meteorological Organization (WMO) and US National Oceanic and Atmospheric Agency (NOAA), is a dynamic community of policymakers, scientists, practitioners, working together for a world where extreme heat is no barrier to lives and livelihoods. GHHIN aims to promote evidence-driven interventions, shared-learning, co-production of information, synthesis of priorities, and capacity building through the establishment of regional hubs around the world.

Southeast Asia Heat Health Hub

The Southeast Asia Heat Health Hub (SEA HHH) is the first regional hub of GHHIN, anchored at the Heat Resilience & Performance Centre (HRPC) at the National University of Singapore's Yong Loo Lin School of Medicine. The mission of SEA HHH is to advance partnership, collaboration, and advocacy within Southeast Asia to protect and prepare for the impacts of heat on human health and well-being.

The 1st GHHIN SEA Heat Health Forum

The theme of the 1st GHHIN Southeast Asia Heat Health Forum is "*Toward a heat resilient Southeast Asia: Enhancing livelihoods and wellbeing*". Convening key stakeholders across the region, the Forum will serve as a pivotal platform for enhancing Southeast Asia's regional capacity, fostering partnerships, and promoting evidence-based policies to manage extreme heat risks effectively in the region. The specially curated agenda will seek to understand heat impacts from a multi-sectoral lens, with a specific focus on urban heat, heat at work, and community, cultural & traditional perspectives.


The event organiser can additionally support exhibitors with local printing and material production at additional costs. Please liaise with them directly after the registration and payment has been completed.

Cancellation

- Any cancellation must be conveyed to the Organising team via email.
- A cancellation charge of 50% fee will be levied if the cancellation is received before 30th November 2024, 23:59 SGT.
- There will be no refund if the cancellation is received on or after 30th November 2024, 23:59 SGT
